Due to the high volume of local COVID-19 cases, and pursuant of the recommendations of the Center for Disease Control, MITW's Emergency Management Coordinator has issued **Emergency Order #22**. This order **takes effect at 6:00 AM on November 6th, 2021, shall expire at 6:00AM on December 4th, 2021** unless extended by the Emergency Management Coordinator.

Below are highlights of the changes made in Emergency Order #22

1. The elder congregate meal sites will reopen for in-person meals.
2. All tribal government facilities are open to the public, but facemask and social distancing of at least 6 feet is still required of anyone inside the building.
3. All events hosted by MTIW may be held as long as event sponsors and attendees adhere to face masking and social distancing safety guidelines.
4. The Rec Center will be opened to fully vaccinated individuals only. Persons using the facility for exercising may do so without a mask. All equipment used must be sanitized immediately after use.

In order to minimize your personal risk of contracting COVID-19 we strongly encourage you to frequently wash your hands with soap and water for more than 20 seconds at a time, utilize masks in public, and get fully vaccinated. Thank you all for your continued efforts to keep yourselves and the community healthy.
