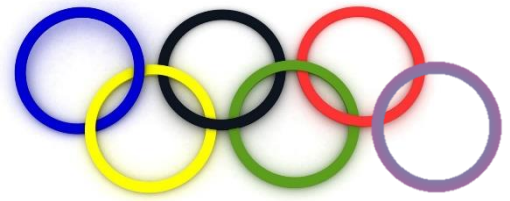


2021 MTS Summer School

Tribal School is pleased to be offering students the opportunity to participate in fun filled learning opportunities through our “2021 Summer Olympics” themed summer school program!

This year the summer school program will be three weeks. The summer program is from Wednesday, June 9th to Wednesday, June 30th, 2021. The summer school program is open to students who are enrolled at MTS and are presently in grades K-7.

Our JUMPSTART program is a three-week program from Monday to Friday *for students who will be entering Tribal School’s Kindergarten in the fall*. All incoming Kindergarteners must be 5 years old by September 1, 2021 in order to be eligible for the fall start date. This is a great program to get your child acquainted with Menominee Tribal School and their teacher for the regular school year.

Activities in Reading & Writing, Math & Science, Menominee Language and culture, Arts & Music and Outdoor Skills will be provided in a relaxed hands-on learning environment that will be centered around this year’s “olympic” theme. All students will receive a nutritious light breakfast and lunch.

Fridays are reserved for field trips. Our field trips are educational as well as super fun. We will visit, Antigo Aquatic Center, Shawano Cinema, National Railroad Museum and our last day we will celebrate with an Olympic Competition and cookout.

Space is limited to 20 students per class so sign-up early! All you need to do is complete the attached registration sheet, fill out the Field Trip Permission section and send it back to school though the mail, email or can be dropped off to the school office. Please fill out a separate application for each child. Once we receive your registration, you will receive back an acceptance notice verifying your child’s acceptance.
