### What does a Junior Achievement volunteer do?

Junior Achievement's unique approach allows volunteers from the community to deliver our curriculum while sharing their experiences with students. JA classroom volunteers transform the key concepts of our lessons into a message that inspires and empowers students to believe in themselves, showing them they can succeed in the world.

### Do I have to prepare the material?

No, the material is provided to you. JA provides you with a easy-to-use facilitator guide, scripts, handouts, posters, activities and other fun in class material. In addition, you will participate in an orientation that shows you how to use the materials and how to add your own personal experiences to make economics come to life in the classroom.

### What is the time commitment and how long are the programs?

The programs range from 30 – 45 minutes per week for 5 to 7 weeks (depending on the grade). Each volunteer should expect to spend 45 minutes per class to prepare.

### Is this program after school or during school?

The Junior Achievement programs are **during school time** and are part of the students' normal curriculum.
